
Hazardous and Noxious Substance (HNS) Incident Management - 3 Days



Course Overview

This course aims to provide participants with a better understanding of how to effectively manage an organisations response to an Hazardous and Noxious Substance Spill or Incident.

The course guides delegates through the processes of strategically managing an HNS incident response, including understanding HNS Substances and importantly how they will react when released or mixed with other substances, the hazards associated with substances, the importance of planning and having an effective management system to support the Tactical Responders, how to obtain specialist advice as well as looking at the complications associated with the disposal of recovered substances.
